## **NORTHWEST ARKANSAS REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION STUDY (NARTS) ANNUAL LISTING OF OBLIGATED PROJECTS (ALOP)**

The Annual Listing of Obligated Projects (ALOP) for which Federal funds were obligated during Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2021 has been published. This document is made available on November, 29, 2021 on the Northwest Arkansas Regional Planning Commission (NWARPC) web site, <http://nwarpc.org/transportation/annual-listing-of-obligated-projects/>, or by calling the NWARPC at 479-751-7125. Additionally, the document is available at the Ozark Regional Transit, Inc. office and the University of Arkansas Razorback Transit office.

Public notice for the ALOP was published in the NWA Democrat Gazette on November 28, 2021, and in the La Prensa Libre and the McDonald County Press on December 2, 2021. The public was invited to comment on the ALOP via written comments through December 17, 2021.

This publication presents a list of projects in the NWARPC Metropolitan Planning Area (MPA) for which Federal funds were obligated during FFY 2021, October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021, on projects in the FFY 2021 - 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The TIP contains an estimate of the Federal funds that will be needed for project phases to progress during a given fiscal year.

The publication of this list is in response to 23 U.S.C. 134(j)(7)(B), 23 U.S.C. 135(g)(4)(B), 49 U.S.C. 5303(j)(7)(B), and 49 U.S.C. 5304(c)(5)(B) as revised by the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21) and the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act, that requires "...an Annual Listing of projects, including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities, for which Federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year shall be published or otherwise made available by the cooperative effort of the State, transit operator, and metropolitan planning organization for public review. The listing shall be consistent with the funding categories identified in each metropolitan transportation improvement program (TIP)."

### **TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS FOR PROGRAM OF PROJECTS (POP):**

The public participation procedures outlined in the NWARPC Public Participation Plan (PPP) with respect to TIP development serve as the public participation process required for the development of transit projects as per FTA Circular 9030.1E. Specifically, the public participation procedures outlined in the PPP concerning the TIP public participation and approval processes carried out by the MPO can serve to satisfy the requirements for public participation under Section 5307. Furthermore, the TIP public participation and approval processes will serve to satisfy the Program of Projects (POP) requirements of the Section 5307, Urbanized Area Formula Grant Program for the University of Arkansas Razorback Transit and Ozark Regional Transit.

The NARTS and any and all public transit operators will address the POP requirements as per FTA Circular 9030.1E. Additionally, any and all public transit operator's capital projects and operational costs are included in the NARTS TIP which is developed through a cooperative and collaborative process with interested parties and other private and public transportation providers.
