## UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM (UPWP) PROPOSED AMENDMENT #1 TO ALLOCATE FUNDS TO CONDUCT A COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY ACTION PLAN

The proposed UPWP Amendment #1 is for NWARPC to allocate \$400,000 STBGP-A funds to complete a consultant-led Regional Comprehensive Safety Action Plan, as described in the FY 2022 Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO), Assistance Listing #20.939 for the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Discretionary Grant Opportunity. The \$400,000 will be matched by local funds. The purpose of the Safety Action Plan is to "improve roadway safety by significantly reducing or eliminating roadway fatalities and serious injuries through safety action plan development and implementation focused on all users, including pedestrians, bicyclists, public transportation users, motorists, personal conveyance and micromobility users, and commercial vehicle operators." Safety Action Plan Components will include Leadership Commitment and Goal Setting, Planning Structure, Safety Analysis, Engagement and Collaboration, Equity Considerations, Policy and Process Changes, Strategy and Project Selections, and Progress and Transparency.
