**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE RAZORBACK TRANSIT
TRANSIT ASSET MANAGEMENT (TAM) PLAN 2022-2026
STATE OF GOOD REPAIR (SGR) PERFORMANCE TARGETS**

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) continues FAST Act and MAP-21's overall performance management approach, within which transit providers invest resources in projects that collectively will make progress toward national goals; and

WHEREAS, all transit agencies must complete a compliant second version of their Transit Asset Management (TAM) Plan by October 2022 and Razorback Transit approved the Transit Asset Management (TAM) Plan 2022-2026, including established State of Good Repair (SGR) Performance Targets, on September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, these performance targets aid in the safe, cost-effective, and reliable public transportation network; and,

WHEREAS, the Northwest Arkansas Regional Planning Commission (NWARPC), as the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Designated Recipient for FTA grant programs and as the officially designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for Fayetteville-Springdale-Rogers metropolitan area, is required to establish performance targets.


