## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY ACTION PLAN AND VISION ZERO POLICY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS,** The City of Rogers is a member of the Northwest Arkansas Regional Planning Commission;

WHEREAS, on May 25, 2022, the Board of Directors of the Northwest Arkansas Regional Planning Commission (NWARPC) approved Resolution # 2022-9 authorizing the submittal of an application to the U.S. DOT for a FY2022 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Discretionary Grant to prepare a Regional Comprehensive Safety Action Plan (CSAP); and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Rogers desires to implement this Comprehensive Safety action Plan and Vision Zero Policy in support of the Northwest Arkansas Regional Planning Commission.

## NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City of Rogers adopts the Regional Comprehensive Safety Action Plan, subject to incorporation of final edits and adoption by the Northwest Arkansas Regional Planning Commission, attached hereto as Exhibit A and makes it part of this resolution, effective immediately;

Section 2: The City of Rogers adopts a Vision Zero Policy which includes the goal of eliminating traffic deaths and serious injuries to zero by 2040 and endorses Vision Zero as a comprehensive and holistic approach to achieving this goal;

<u>Section 3: Severability Provision</u>: If any part of this Resolution is held invalid, the remainder of this Resolution shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

<u>Section 4: Repeal of Conflicting Provisions</u>: All resolutions or orders of the City Council, or parts of resolutions or orders of the City Council, in conflict with the Resolution, are repealed to the extent of the conflict.
