## **REQUEST FOR LETTERS OF INTEREST**

February 23, 2024

Notice is hereby given that the Northwest Arkansas Regional Planning Commission (NWARPC) is seeking Letters of Interest from qualified firms for updating the NWARPC Travel Demand Model and completing a Transit Alternatives Study.

The update of the Travel Demand Model will forecast the Northwest Arkansas future year transportation system, evaluate the impact of alternative transportation solutions for the development of long-range transportation plans, and support decision makers by providing information about transportation alternatives and land use scenarios. The Travel Demand Model will be used to inform the 2050 NWARPC Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).

The purpose of the Transit Alternatives Study is to investigate high-capacity transit options including commuter rail, light rail and bus rapid transit to regionally connect Northwest Arkansas using existing highway and rail corridors. The study should be done considering requirements for the FTA Capital Improvements Grant program for New Starts and Small Starts. The study should account for regional demographics and population, future land use plans, and previously completed transportation studies such as the 2014 Transportation Alternatives Study.

This project includes federal funds and requires the selected firm to comply with Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Certifications and Assurances and comply with Arkansas state procurement laws, rules, and regulations including but not limited to Ethical Standards (Ark. Code Ann. §19-11-708), Employee and Relative Disclosure, and Equal Opportunity Policy.

Work and contract requirements shall conform with the requirements of Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration, Arkansas Department of Transportation and NWARPC. Interested firms should note that in order to comply with state and federal requirements, NWARPC will verify suspension and debarment actions and eligibility status of firms in accordance with 2 CFR Part 1200 and 2 CFR Part 180.

## **SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Interested firms must furnish:

- 1. A cover letter with the firm's response including primary contact information.
- 2. Information regarding the firm's experience in similar work.
- The firm's completed Architect-Engineer Qualifications Standard Form (SF) 330 Parts I and II (48 CFR §53.236-2(b)). (SF 330 is available on the Department's website.)

After a review of all letters of interest received, selected firms will be furnished a scope of work and requested to submit proposals for accomplishing the work. All work and contract requirements shall conform to applicable state and federal requirements.

PROTEST PROCEDURE: Protestors may file a protest on any phase of solicitation or award, including but not limited to specification or award. Protests are to be submitted in writing and received by the NWARPC's Executive Director, at 1311 Clayton St., Springdale, AR, 72762 within seven (7) working days after the aggrieved person knows or should have known of the facts giving rise thereto. Protests based upon restrictive specifications or alleged improprieties in any type of solicitation, which are apparent prior to bid opening or the closing date for receipt of initial proposals, should be filed no later than three (3) working days prior to bid opening or the closing date for receipt of proposals.
