RE: FFY 2026 NWARPC Funding Program Recommendations

## FFY 2026 TIMELINE AND ACTION

Following Board approval, the Northwest Arkansas Regional Planning Commission (NWARPC) issued a call for projects on January 5, 2025, with the application deadline being April 3, 2025 at 11:59 p.m., CT for the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2026 NWARPC formula funding programs, including the Surface Transportation Block Grant Program – Attributable (STBGP-A), Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) and Carbon Reduction Program (CRP).

The selection committee was formed using one representative from each of the applying entities and any volunteers who wished to participate. The committee included:

The selection committee toured and scored the projects and discussed award recommendations on Wednesday, May 7, 2025. On May 15, 2025, the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) voted to forward these recommendations to the RPC/Policy Committee for consideration.

### FFY 2026 FUNDING ESTIMATES

The assumptions for the FFY 2026 funding estimates are based on FFY 2025 published apportionments with an assumed 100% obligation limitation (OL), including additional funds not awarded in FFY 2025 and FFY2025 TIFIA Redistribution. FFY 2026 apportionment funding requires Congressional action.

### FFY 2026 PROJECT REQUESTS

NWARPC received 24 project applications representing 21 unique projects. Three (3) projects were submitted for consideration under multiple funding programs. Of the applications received, seven (7) are for existing STBGP-A projects "in the pipeline"; six (6) are for new STBGP-A projects; six (6) are for TAP funding; and five (5) are for CRP funding.

The total funding requested across the 21 projects is \$26,250,345—approximately \$9.6 million more than the estimated available funding for FFY 2026.

### SELECTION COMMITTEE DISCUSSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The committee discussed and considered the following:

- Balancing support for existing "pipeline" projects not yet fully funded with the long-term costs of adding new projects.
- Rising construction costs leading to increased funding requests.
- Treating existing STBGP-A projects as priorities, without re-scoring, due to prior Board approval.
- Program requirements, including funding limits and FHWA Functional Classification (collector or above).
- Project timelines and readiness, per the ARDOT Local Public Agency Manual, to meet the September 2026 obligation deadline.
- A goal to distribute funding across as many communities as possible.
- FFY 2026 funding is subject to congressional action and federal priority changes.

Additionally, projects that did not receive their full funding request are encouraged to reapply in the FFY 2027 NWARPC Funding Program Cycle, anticipated to begin in January 2026.

The committee chose not to score and rank projects. The committee instead used the following to derive their recommendations:

- **TAP and CRP Requests** all TAP and CRP requests were able to be fully funded within the estimated program budgets. However, due to potential shifts in federal priorities, the committee recommended a provision stating that *should FFY 2026 CRP funding not be appropriated by Congress, the approved CRP projects will be prioritized for funding in the next cycle using TAP funds, if eligible under TAP.*
- **STBGP-A Requests** The committee chose to explore whether funding requests could be reduced to fit within the estimated program budget. Where sponsors were unable to voluntarily reduce their requests, project amounts were adjusted proportionally (pro rata) to stay within the funding limit.

**Provision** – Due to potential shifts in federal priorities, the committee recommended a provision stating that should FFY 2026 CRP funding not be appropriated by Congress, the approved CRP projects will be prioritized for funding in the next FFY 2027 NWARPC funding cycle using TAP funds, if eligible under TAP.

#### FFY 2026 NWARPC FUNDING RECOMMENDATION:

The selection committee developed the following funding recommendations, which were reviewed and recommended by TAC on May 15, 2025.

**Recommended Board Motion:** to approve the FFY 2026 NWARPC Funding Program (STBGP-A, TAP, and CRP) project awards as shown in the funding allocation table, with the provision that should FFY 2026 Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) funding not be appropriated by Congress, the awarded CRP projects will be prioritized for funding in the next FFY 2027 NWARPC funding cycle using TAP funds, if eligible under TAP.
