

**NWARPC RESOLUTION 2026-03**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RAZORBACK GREENWAY  
CORRIDOR PLAN REGIONAL FRAMEWORK**

**WHEREAS**, the Northwest Arkansas Regional Planning Commission (NWARPC), as the region's Metropolitan Planning Organization and Council of Governments, coordinates transportation planning and regional collaboration and has advanced major multimodal initiatives and regional plans, including administration of federal and philanthropic investments supporting development of the Razorback Regional Greenway; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution #2024-13, NWARPC applied for and accepted funding through the Walton Family Foundation's Northwest Arkansas Design Excellence Program Planning Grant to develop, in collaboration with the seven cities the Greenway traverses, a consultant-led Razorback Greenway Corridor Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Razorback Greenway Corridor Plan establishes a regional framework to guide coordinated land use, placemaking, transportation connectivity, safety improvements, economic development opportunities, environmental stewardship, and strategic investment along the Greenway corridor; and


**WHEREAS**, the Corridor Plan was developed through coordination with member jurisdictions, stakeholders, and the public, and is intended to serve as a long-range guide to support implementation, partnerships, and funding competitiveness.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NORTHWEST ARKANSAS REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION/POLICY COMMITTEE:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Razorback Greenway Corridor Plan Regional Framework is hereby adopted.

**SECTION 2.** That NWARPC shall utilize the Framework to support collaboration with member governments and partners in advancing implementation strategies, pursuing funding opportunities and additional phases, and promoting coordinated investment along the Razorback Greenway corridor.
