NARTS 2025-2028 TIP AMENDMENT #4: The NWARPC, in conjunction with Ozark Regional Transit (ORT) Authority, the Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT), and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), have determined an amendment to the Northwest Arkansas Regional Transportation Study (NARTS) FFY 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is necessary to include changes to the ORT FTA 5307 categorical distribution of FFY 2024 funding.
